## The Baptism of Our Lord

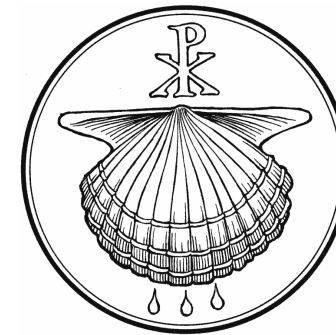
