***Black History Month Service - February 11, 2024 – Guest Soprano Denise Williams** – Soprano Denise Williams, a 30-year veteran of the concert, opera, and theatre stage, has electrified audiences from Canada to Cuba, and many points in between. Moving effortlessly between vocal styles, she has worked with The Nathaniel Dett Chorale, The Toronto Symphony Orchestra, Toronto Mendelssohn Choir, Mirvish Productions, and most recently, the Orquesta Sinfonica de Oriente in Cuba.

Ongoing projects include WALK TOGETHER CHILDREN, a Cross-Cultural Concert Celebration of Black, Jewish, Muslim diaspora and MELANATTÉ a fusion of Classical and Romantic hits with a modern Black context, in collaboration with its brainchild, Rapsodius. “Denise Williams offers powerfully authentic renditions of the most beloved songs - all in a fresh, sometimes striking new musical context that will have audiences clamouring for more.”Rapsodius

Denise holds a BSc, ARCT Diploma in Singing, and a Masters in Community Music. She dedicates her time to leadership in the performing arts: as founding artistic director of the charitable theatre organization, No Strings Theatre, on the music theatre voice faculty of Sheridan College, and operating her Voices of Colour Music studio.

Denise is honoured to be on the 2024 list of 100 Black Accomplished Canadian Women Honourees.
